This year, for the first time, the TMA is participating in a new fundraising program. This event will be in addition to other fundraisers you will see throughout the year. We have the opportunity of making a large amount of money, depending on participation. So we need **YOU** as well as any and all family members **14 years and older**.

Funds raised from this event will go back to the students by way of scholarships, Band Camp, reduced All State Fees, Award Night, and other areas in support of our music students.

Below you will find an overview of NHMS requirements as well as helpful hints and instructions. Attached is a map indicating where to park in Concord. Car pooling is recommended from your home to Concord. We will be bused to the race track from the Department of Safety parking lot on Hazen Drive, see map. No driving to the race track other than by bus is allowed due to heavy traffic exiting the speedway.

## General Information

- Come dressed for all types of weather. If a race has been run, there will be clean up.
- Please wear closed toe shoes (sneakers).
- Long pants are recommended (seat corners may have sharp edges).
- Please do not bring valuables.
- Rows will be assigned, please no running or jumping from seat to seat.
- Plastic gloves and trash bags will be supplied at the race track.
- Parents/Adults may be asked to oversee students who they have carpooled with.
- If you wish to bring food, it is recommended that you do so in a throw away container to eliminate the need to carry it around.

- Water and restrooms will be available after clean up BUT there will be no concession open.

### Requirements

- **ALL** students ages 14 -17 **MUST** have a permission form signed by a parent/guardian **PRIOR** to boarding the bus. Please make sure your student has the signed form, there is NO provision without the signed form. No copies please.
- Anyone 18 years or older will be asked to sign a waiver at the track before work can begin.
- Anyone 18 years or older is also asked to sign in. No pay will be given without signing in.

### Hints Suggestions and Miscellaneous

- It has been suggested that some participants may find an inexpensive (the Dollar Store) hand held broom and dust pan.
- If we are at the race track and it begins to rain, ponchos will be provided.
- Please arrive at the Department of Safety (see map) on Hazen Drive by **2:45 pm**, the bus leaves promptly at **3:00 pm**.
- We will have approximately an hour to an hour and a half of down time waiting for the race to end and the clean up to begin. There will be tables and chairs available. No concessions. This may be a good time to have a bite to eat – disposable being the key. Cleaning will start at approximately 5:15 pm and be completed about 7 pm, depending on the number of participants. The track's goal is to be done by 7pm.
