Minutes: The Secretary's report was accepted as written.

Treasurer's Report: The Treasurer's report was accepted as written.

Officers' Report: Lauren Paley reported that the Select Choir is working on selections such as *When I Fall in Love* and *Old Black Magic* for the Clark Terry Festival on March 15th and then will return to preparing their program for Large Group on March 29th.

Courtney Tilley, representing Orchestra and Chamber Orchestra, reported that both groups are practicing for the upcoming concert on March 12th and for Large Group. Also, some musicians are preparing for the All State Festival (April 3-5) and for the musical production of *My Fair Lady*.

Discussion Topics:

◆ ***Yard Sale: (Wanda McAlevey):*** The TMA Yard Sale will be held on Saturday May 3rd which is the same day as the quilt show being held at the Middle School. Space will be sold for \$25 for a two parking space area. All participants need to take home all unsold merchandise. Advertisements will be placed in the Carriage Town News, Tri-Town Paper and the local cable stations.

◆ ***Water Sale:*** We will once again sell bottled water at the TRHS graduation scheduled for Friday June 13th.

◆ ***Concert CD Sales:*** It was decided to offer CD audio recordings of the last series of school concerts for ten dollars each. The tech department will assist with the recordings and share the profits.

◆ ***Fisher Cat Fundraiser (Gill Lane):*** This fundraiser has been scheduled for Sunday afternoon, June 29th. TMA will need to sell a minimum of 125 tickets which will be purchased from the Fischer Cat organization for \$5 and then sold for \$8. We will also be helping to sell 50/50 raffle tickets (TMA would earn 25%) and assisting in the concession stand. For the concession stand the Fisher Cats will provide the food and TMA will need 10 adult volunteers to run the stand. TMA will earn 5-6% of the concession stand proceeds.

◆ ***Variety Show:*** Due to several schedule conflicts, the Variety Show will not be held this year. It will be planned for next year.

◆ ***Senior Bios:*** The deadline for seniors to submit their senior bios for the TMA yearbook is April 1st.

◆ ***Scholarship:*** It was voted to increase the number of scholarships this year from two to three (\$500 each). Recipients are chosen by the High School Scholarship committee.

◆ ***Music Awards Night:*** The music department Awards Night will be held on Thursday May 22nd.

◆ ***March Concerts:*** The dates for the March concerts are: 10th - High School/Middle School Jazz, 12th - Grades 6-12 Orchestra, 15th - Clark Terry Jazz Festival at UNH, 19th - Grades 5-7 Band, 24th - Grades 5-7 Chorus, 26th - Grades 8-12 Chorus, 27th - Grades 8-12 Band, 29th - Large Group Festival at Bow High School.
